

Thank you Co-Chairs. My name is Anna Malos and I am speaking on behalf of the Climate Action Network.

For the ADP to succeed, firstly elements of the LCA must be concluded at Doha: ie 2015 as a global peak year, comparable ambition and common accounting. A KP second commitment period must be adopted – providing momentum and architectural elements for future deals.

Work must start immediately on PRE-2020 AMBITION to agree concrete actions to close the ambition gap. Parties should commission a technical paper to quantify this gap and ways to close it. And finance over the next few years must AT LEAST double from fast start levels so that developing countries can increase mitigation and undertake adaptation.

THE process toward the 2015 DEAL requires a clear work plan with timelines and milestones. We suggest compilation text by COP19, complete negotiating text by COP20, and a draft protocol circulated by May 2015. The mapping of this work plan must begin here and be agreed at Doha.

The fair, ambitious and legally binding 2015 agreement must build on, develop and improve the rules already agreed in the KP and Convention - assuring that countries are accountable for delivering on their agreements, with common accounting rules and a common, but differentiated, MRV system to allow transparency.

The lack of an equitable approach to sharing the costs of mitigation and adaptation amongst countries has been a stumbling block. The ADP must urgently start a work program on options for the allocation of fair shares of global effort.
